Minutes of the June 24th, 2026 Meeting

1. **Call to Order and Roll Call:** The regular meeting of the Corona de Tucson Fire District Governing Board was called to order by Chairman Weber at CDTFD Fire Station #1 at 18:01. Board members also present were Mr. Karhoff and Mr. Wagner. Mr. Edwards and Mr. McKnight. Also, present was Captain Culver Dobbin and Chief Lunde by telephone. There were 7 members of the public present.
2. **Pledge of Allegiance:** Mr. Weber led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. **Employee/Public Recognition:** FF Lechner was recognized by Captain Cupell for going out of his way to help a resident in need.
4. **Call to the Public:** No Requests
5. **Reading and Approval of Minutes:** Minutes of the Corona Fire District Regular meeting held May 27th, 2026, were presented for approval. Mr. Karhoff made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Mr. McKnight seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
6. **Chief Report:**
Management Update: Chief Lunde updated the Board that fire subscriptions have gone out.
7. **Administrative Report:**
Financials- Gabe Buldra of JVG presented the May financial reports. Mr. McKnight made a motion to approve the reports as presented. Mr. Karhoff seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
8. **Operations Report:**
Captain Cupell reported to the Board on operations and the monthly call volume. (see attached report)
9. **Prevention Report:** Fire Marshal Will Croasdale presented the month Prevention activities
10. **IAFF Local 3504 Report:** Vice President Dobbin presented local 3504 report and attend PFFA conference.
11. **Old Business:**
 - A. **Approval of FY2027 Operating Budget as Posted**
Mr. Weber made a motion to open the public meeting to address comments from the community in reference to the Corona De

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Tucson Fire Districts operating budget for Fiscal year 2027. Mr. Karhoff seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Public discussion on budget. There were no requests to speak. Chief Lunde advised the board that there were no comments made during the review period.

B. Ratification and approval of the FY26 operating budget. Mr. Weber made a motion to approve the budget as posted per statute without changes and notify the appropriate authorities. Mr. Karhoff seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously during the public discussion. Chief Lunde reported that he has not received any public comment while budget was posted.

12. **New Business:**

A. Discussion and possible action on the approving of the FY 25 PSPRS pension funding policy.

- i. Gabe Buldra of JVG presented the pension funding policy. This is the same policy that we have been following for the past few years and there were no changes. Mr. Weber made a motion to approve the pension funding policy as presented. Mr. Edwards seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Discussion and possible action on removing a former employee of the district from Corona de Tucson Fire District BOFA checking account.

- i. Chief Lunde presented to the board that he went to close the Corona de Tucson Fire District BOFA and was unable to do so because a former employee was still listed on the account. Chief Lunde asked that the board approve of removing former employee Glenda Holm from Corona de Tucson Fire District BOFA checking account. Mr. Weber made a motion to remove Glenda Holm from the Corona de Tucson Fire District checking account. Mr. McKnight seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

C. Discussion and possible action on entering into IGA with Pima County for the Fire Agency Prevention Patrol Program

- i. Captain Dobbins presented the new IGA from Pima County to engage the Corona de Tucson Fire District into a prevention patrol program with Pima County. Mr. Weber made a motion to enter into the Fire Agency Prevention Patrol Program with Pima County. Mr. Karhoff seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
